### PTE. COCHRANE KILLED.

Official information has reached Coatbridge to the effect that Private William Cochrane, Seaforth Highlanders, 37 Revie's Land, Whifflet, has been killed in action. Deceased, who was 28 years of age, was a Reservist, and was two years in India before the outbreak of the present war. He was employed in the Clifton Ironworks. A brother of deceased, Sergeant John Cochrane, is serving with the H.L.I.

### PTE. ALEX. DALZIEL KILLED.

Private Alex. Dalziel, Black Watch, who was reported missing on 21st Jan., 1915, is now officially reported killed. He enlisted shortly after the outbreak of war. When in Coatbridge deceased was employed in the Victoria Ironworks.
