In his Will dated 26/06/1915 John left all his property and effects to his mother with the exception of a gold buckle ring in the possession of his mother which he gave to Miss Florence Elizabeth Oliver of 12 Percy St, Ibrox, Glasgow.

### **Additional Information**

John was Killed in Action on New Years Day 1917. Also remembered on the Coatbridge Technical College, Coats Parish Church and Coatbridge High Schools Rolls of Honour (see photos). Johns grave inscription reads " FATHER IN THY GRACIOUS >>> KEEPING LEAVE WE NOW OUR LOVED ONE >>> SLEEPING "

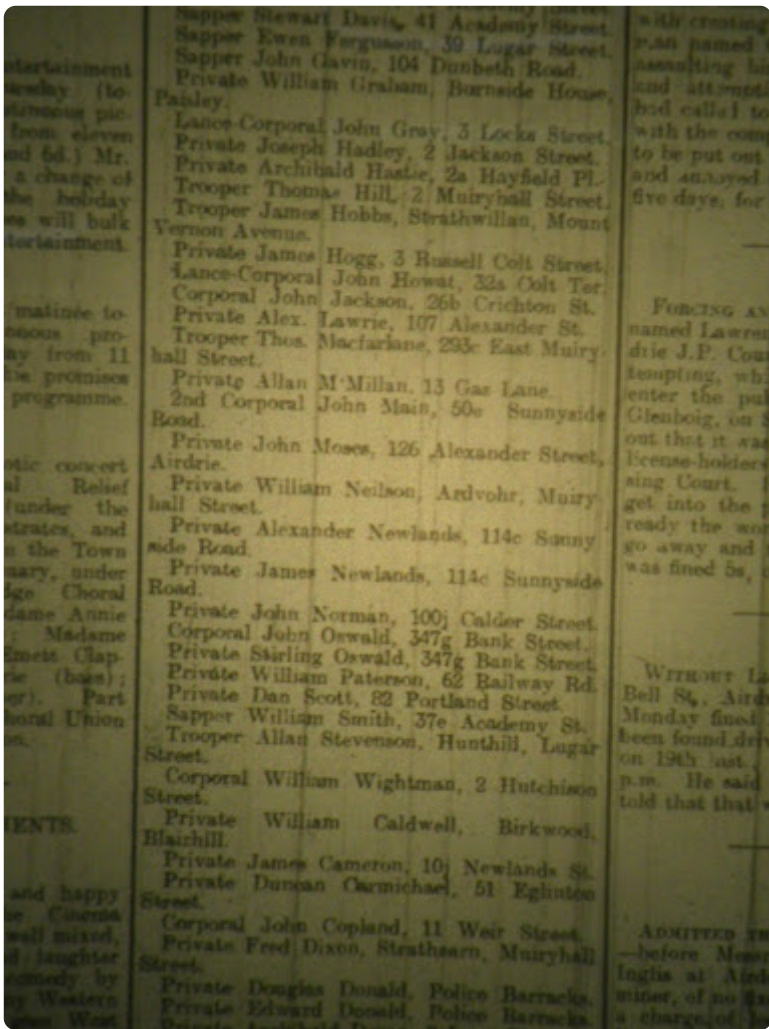

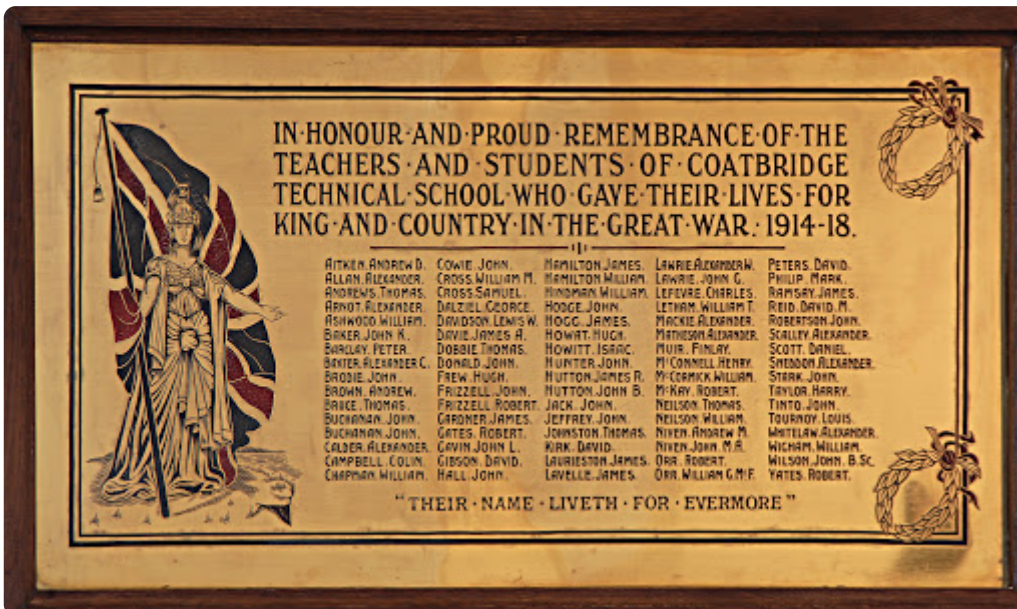

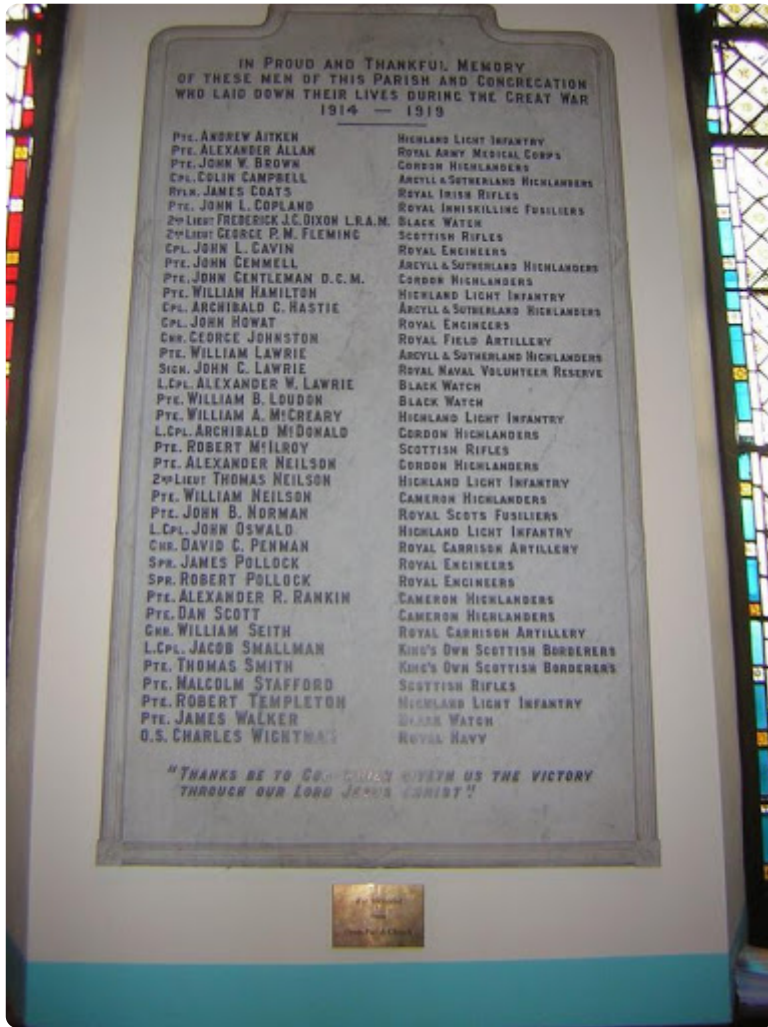
Coatbridge Express 30/12/1914 Coats Parish Church Roll of Honour
