CHATHAM SOLDIERS MISSING.

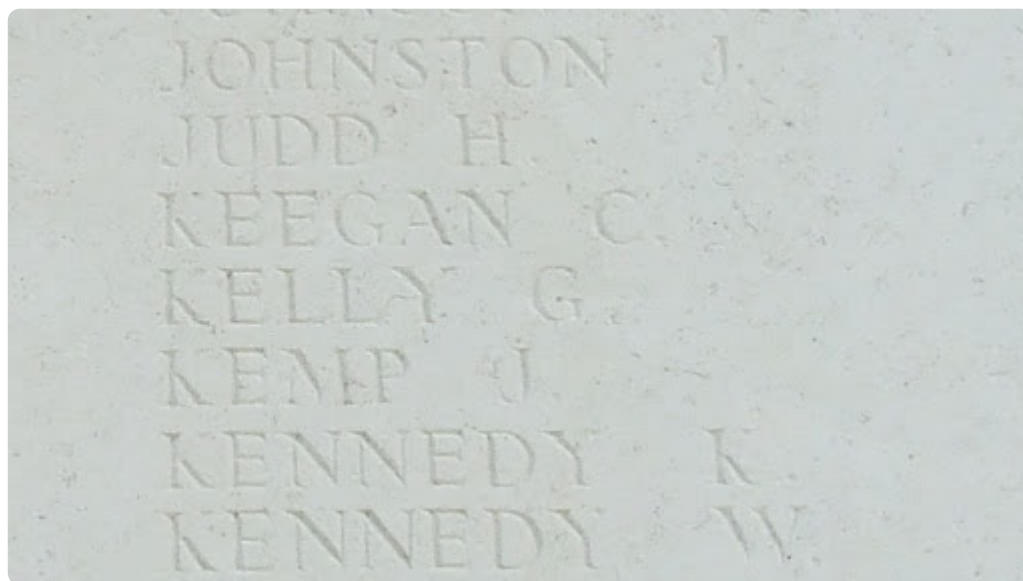
