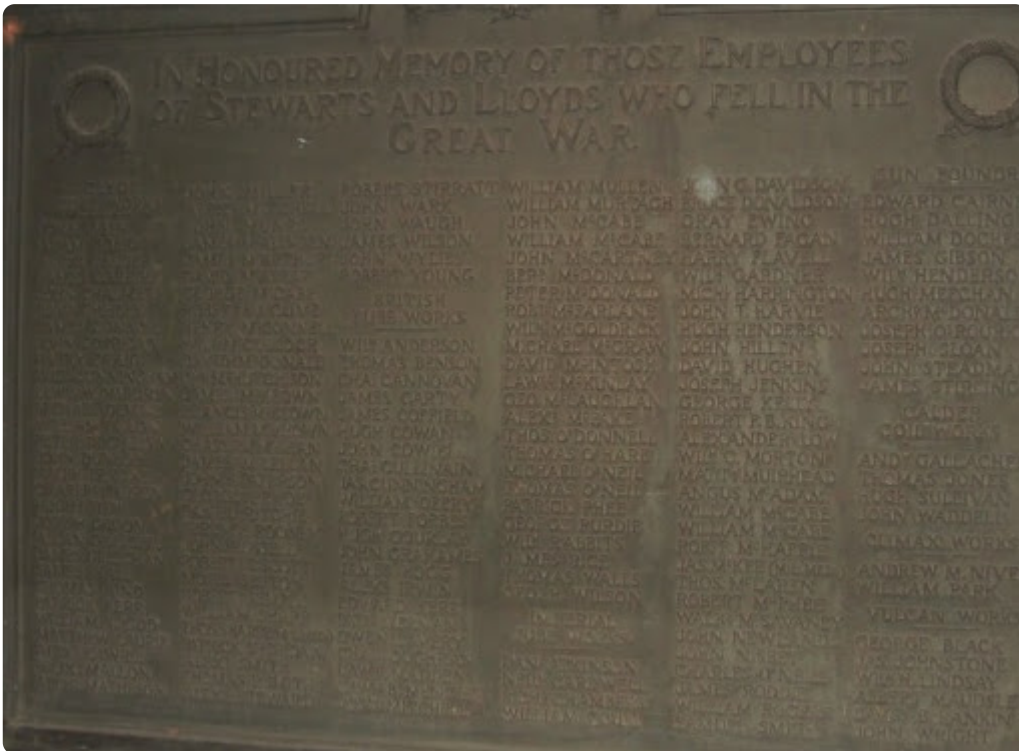
TWO SONS LOST.
