



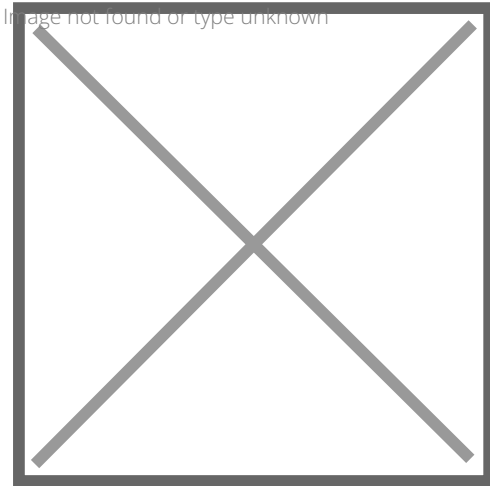

Killed in Action on the 25/04/1915 at the Battle of St. Julien (part of the 2nd Battles of Ypres), age 34. From the 1901 Census - Address - 23g Sunnyside Rd, Coatbridge - Thomas was a boarder - James McQueeney aged 32, Mary McQueeney aged 24, Jessie McQueeney aged 5, James McQueeney aged 3, Patrick McQueeney aged 2, Maggie McQueeney aged 14 and boarder Thomas Burns aged 21. Mrs Clara Downie is listed as Guardian of Thomas and she received his property and effects. Employment was Miner in Rosehall Colliery, Coatbridge / Reservist.
