Killed in Action on the 25/09/1915 on the opening day of the Battle of Loos, age 23. Son of James and Christina Drummond Cairns of 38 Main St, Calderbank, Airdrie previously 23 Sunnyside Rd, Coatbridge. Brother of Mrs Maggie Fraser (married to Bruce). From the 1901 Census - Address - 84b Bank St, Coatbridge - James Cairns aged 50, Christina Cairns aged 42, Christina Cairns aged 15, Margaret Cairns aged 13, Elizabeth Cairns aged 10, James Cairns aged 7, William Cairns aged 5. James' Pension was awarded to his mother Christina of 33 Sunnyside Rd, Coatbridge on the 03/08/1916. Employment was Underhand Puddler in the Stewarts and Lloyds Waverley Iron Works, Coatbridge / Territorial.
