## Corporal Colin Campbell

## 11th (Service) Battalion Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Service No: S/7103

Killed in Action on the 03/07/1916 when an enemy shell landed on his working party, age 20 / DOB - 05/06/1896. Only son of Hugh and Betsy M Campbell of 17d Eglinton St, Coatbridge. Colin left everything to his father in his Will. From the 1901 Census - Address - 17d Eglinton St, Coatbridge - Hugh Campbell aged 45, Betsy M Campbell aged 41, Margaret J Campbell aged 6, Colin Campbell aged 4 and Mother Betsy's Father James Jack aged 78. Colin's Pension was awarded to his father Hugh on the 19/01/1917. Employment was Apprentice Engineer in the Sunnyside Engineering Works.
