



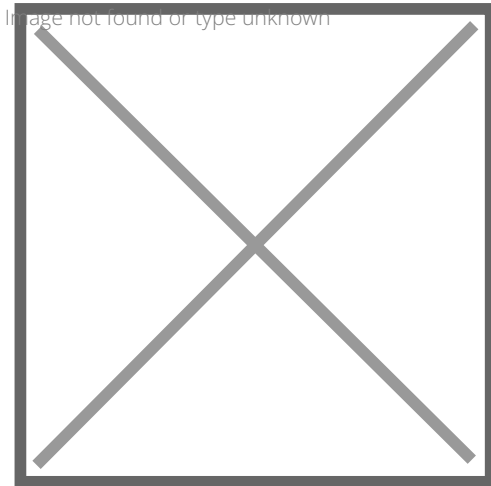

Killed in Action on the 01/11/1914 at the Battle of Messines, age 25 / DOB -1889. Eldest son of James Carty and Elizabeth Owens Carty from Irvine. From the 1901 Census - Address - 3 Howes St, Coatbridge - James Carty aged 46, Elizabeth Carty aged 35, Jane Carty aged 16, James Carty aged 12, John Carty aged 9, Mary Carty aged 4, Agnes Carty aged 4, Elizabeth Carty aged 2. Employment was Labourer / Tube Worker in the British Tube Works / Territorial.
