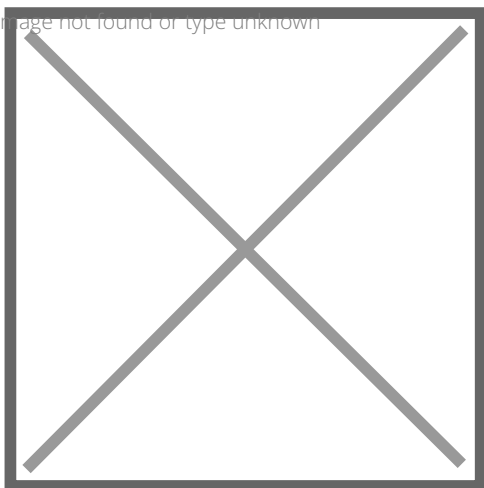

Killed in Action on the 10/03/1915 at the Battle of Neuve Chapelle, age 32 / DOB - 04/04/1882. Eldest son of Patrick and Ann (Annie) Murphy Cassidy of 13c Buchanan St, Coatbridge who arrived in Coatbridge around 1870 from Ireland. From the 1901 Census - Address - 7 Coatbank St, Coatbridge - Patrick Cassidy aged 50, Ann Cassidy aged 46, Mary Cassidy aged 13, Sarah Cassidy aged 11, James Cassidy aged 8, Edward Cassidy aged 6. James' Pension was awarded to his mother Annie on the 01/04/1919. Employment was Chemical Mixer, Langloan Chemical Works, Coatbridge / Reservist.
