Died of Wounds on the 08/07/1916 received at Hohenzollern sector, Vermelles, age 33. Oldest son of James and Annie Shaw Coffield. Husband of Jane (Jeannie) Lindsay Coffield of 90c Buchanan St, Coatbridge. Father of 5 children. They were Helen Gilmore Coffield born 11/05/1908, Ann Shaw Coffield born 23/10/1909, James Coffield born 20/03/1911, Jeanie Campbell Lindsay Coffield born 10/06/1913 and Elizabeth Shanks Coffield born 09/04/1915. From the 1901 Census - Address - 31 Russell Colt St, Coatbridge - James Coffield aged 52, Annie Shaw Coffield aged 45, Elizzie Coffield aged 12, James Coffield aged 17, Marion Coffield aged 10, Annie Coffield aged 8, Robina Coffield aged 7. James' Pension was awarded to his wife Jeannie on the 08/01/1917. Their 5 children are also listed. Employment was Tube Worker in the British Tube Works.
