



7th (South Irish Horse) Battalion Royal Irish Regiment "A" Company Service No: 26597

Killed in Action on the 02/09/1918 during the Capture of Wulverghem (Advance in Flanders), age DOB - 1877. Husband of Mary Corrigan Colgan (06/01/1875 -) of 68q Coats St, Coatbridge. Father of 4 children, Mary Agnes born 21/05/1904, Patrick born 09/06/1907, Michael Edward born 04/07/1908 and Thomas born 06/12/1913. All of Patrick's property and effects were left to his wife Mary. Patrick's Pension was awarded to his wife Mary on the 26/03/1919. Their 4 children are also listed. Employment was Furnace Filler, Calder Iron Works.
