1/8th (The Argyllshire) Battalion Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders Service No: S/18810

Killed in Action (leg wound) on the 22/03/1918 at the Battle of St. Quentin (phase of the 1st Battles of the Somme 1918), age 19 / DOB - 12/08/1898. Eldest son of Robert (1876 - 26/02/1928) and Mary Connell (1879 - 31/12/1953) of 10 William St, Coatbridge. From the 1901 Census - Address - 10 Nimmos Row, Holytown, Lanarkshire - Robert Connell aged 23, Mary Connell aged 21, William Connell aged 2, Robert Connell (11/03/1900 - 15/05/1916) aged 1, boarders Alexander McCluckie aged 19 and Alfred McCluckie aged 14. William had 5 more sisters and 1 more brother, Susan born 17/06/1906, Grace (11/10/1907 - 18/11/1907), Margaret (Peggy) (1910 - 1984), Sarah McLuckie (29/01/1913 - 1983), Thomas (18/03/1914 - 1988), and Annie. Employment was Barman with Mr Melaugh.
