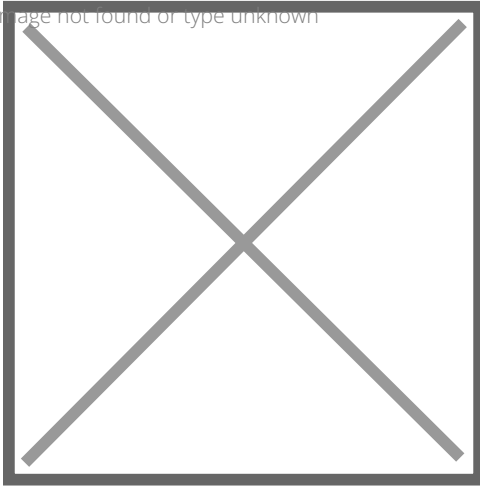

Killed in Action on the 25/09/1915 on the opening day of the Battle of Loos, age No data. Son of Mr and Mrs Mary Dickson of 17 Stewart St, Coatbridge. Alexander's mother sent him a parcel which was returned marked "killed". Alexander's Pension was awarded to his mother Mary of 17 Stewart St, Coatbridge then 75c Biggar Rd, Airdrie on the 14/09/1916. Employment was Waverley Iron Works.
