Killed in Action on the 19/01/1916 in the Hulloch sector, Loos Salient, age 40 / DOB - 28/04/1875. Son of James (19/05/1852 - 15/11/1912) and Rachael Rae Dickson (1856 - 27/11/1896). Husband of Mary Hinton Reid Dickson (12/03/1874 - 25/12/1938) of 135c Sunnyside Rd, Coatbridge. Father of 6 children. Daughters - Mary Hinton Reid Dickson (05/06/1895 - 1974), Rachael Rae Dickson (30/01/1898 -), Agnes (13/05/1911 -) and Sarah (18/01/1913 -). Sons - James Dickson (28/11/1900 -), William Reid Dickson (30/08/1902 - 1970) and David Dickson (04/03/1906 -). From the 1901 Census - Address - 124i Buchanan St, Coatbridge - Daniel Dickson aged 25, Mary Dickson aged 27, Mary Dickson aged 5, Rachael Dickson aged 3, James Dickson aged 4 months. From the 1891 Census - Address - 212 Bank St, Coatbridge - Father James Dickson aged 38, Mother Rachael Dickson aged 35, Daniel Dickson aged 12 and sister Margaret Dickson aged 12. Daniel's Pension was awarded to his wife Mary on the 27/07/1916.

Daniel's children William, Daniel, Agnes and Sarah also listed. Employment was Tinplate Iron Works.
