Killed in Action on the 26/10/1917 at the 2nd Battle of Passchendaele (part of the Battles of Ypres 1917), age 24 / DOB - 03/03/1893. Son of Richard and Mary Ann Quinn Docherty of 441 Main St, Coatbridge. From the 1901 Census - Address - 126e Alexander St, Coatbridge - Richard Docherty aged 44, Mary Docherty aged 35, Mary Docherty aged 17, James Docherty aged 13 and Richard Docherty aged 8. Richard's Pension was awarded to his mother Mary Ann on the 06/05/1918. Employment was Bricklayer.
