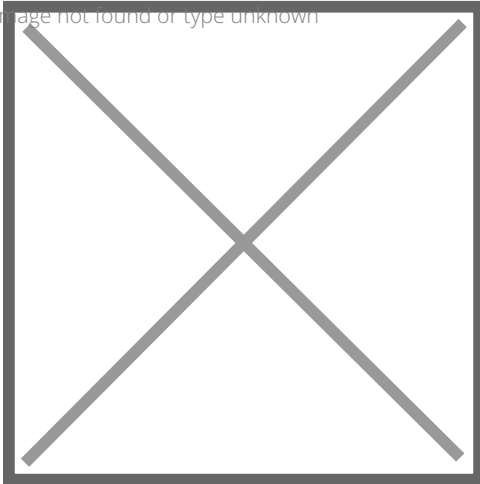

Killed in Action on the 02/10/1915 at Gun Trench, Hulloch Road during the Battle of Loos, age 48. Son of William Edward and Catherine Douglas. Husband of Maggie Douglas of Lamont House, Buchanan St, Coatbridge. Edward's Pension was awarded to his brother Mr J. Douglas of 49 Derwent Street, Workington, Cumberland. Employment was Iron Worker in the Woodside Iron Works.
