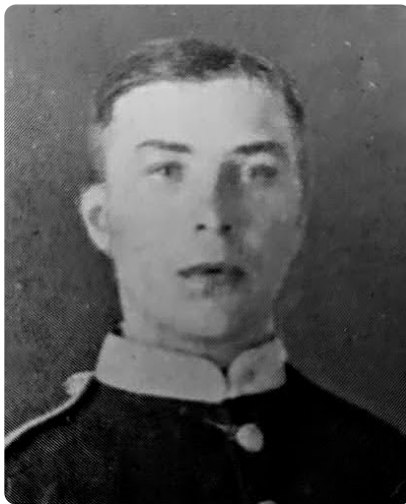

Peter Downie

**1st Garrison Battalion Gordon Highlanders
Service No: 16258**

Died on the 01/11/1918 at home from Malaria, age 26 / DOB - 26/12/1891. Son of Michael Downie (1861 - 03/11/1905) and Mary Ann Phee Downie. Peter's mother remarried James Lawrie and they lived at Whifflet St, Coatbridge. This is where Peter died. Peter's stepbrother Private John Downie of the 2nd Battalion Royal Scots (6831) was Killed in Action at Kemmel on the 21/04/1915. From the 1901 Census - Address - 49g Coatbank St, Coatbridge - Michael Downie aged 40, Mary A Downie aged 52 (?), Patrick Downie aged 15, Michael Downie aged 9, Peter Downie aged 9 (twins), Catherine Downie aged 5, Margaret Downie aged 3. Peter's 2 brothers also served. Peter's Pension was awarded to his mother Mary Ann of 71f Whifflet St, Coatbridge. Employment was Iron Worker at the Horse Shoe Works.
