



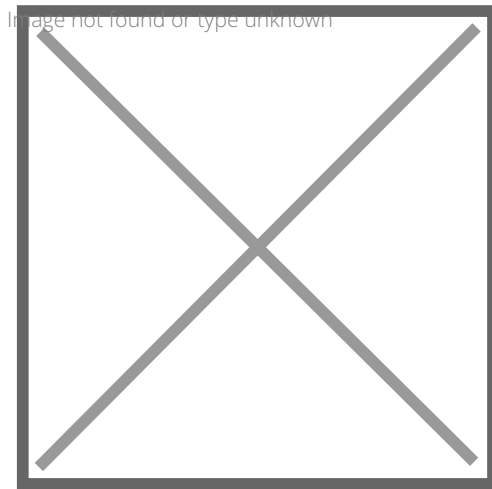

Died on the 15/11/1918 at the 4th General Hospital, Camiers, France, age 44. Son of John Doyle of 13 Turner St, Coatbridge. From the 1891 Census - Address - 12 Bogside, Old Monkland, Coatbridge - John Doyle aged 57, Bridget Doyle aged 19, Thomas Doyle aged 17, John Doyle aged 15. From the 1901 Census - Address - 4 Howes, Old Monkland, Coatbridge - John Doyle, Bridget Doyle aged 29, Thomas Doyle aged 27, John Doyle aged 25. Thomas' Pension was awarded to his father John. Employment was Coal Hewer / Miner.
