Killed in Action on the 06/05/1916 at the Hohenzollern Sector near Loos, age 23. Eldest son of John (1854 - 1905) and Margaret Wright Gray Ewing (1866 - 1955) of 22e King St, Coatbridge. Archibald's younger brother Sapper Gray Ewing of the Royal Engineers Died of Wounds at Gallipoli on the 13/07/1915. From the 1901 Census - Address - 70g North Academy St, Coatbridge - John Ewing aged 47, Margaret Ewing aged 34, Archibald Ewing aged 7, Gray Ewing aged 5, Elizabeth Ewing aged 2. Archie and Gray's Pension was awarded to their mother Margaret. Employment was Iron Worker in the Dundyvan Iron Works.
