Sergeant Ralph Erskine

17th (Service) Battalion (3rd Glasgow) Highland Light Infantry Service No: 15566

Died of Wounds on the 23/02/1917 at the Edmonton Hospital, London. Wounds received on the 09/08/1916 at Cambryn, age 26 / DOB - 05/03/1891. Son of Ralph Colley Smith Erskine (1851 - 23/06/1917) and Agnes Brown Erskine (1853 - 08/08/1923). Ralph's father died exactly 4 months after he died. From the 1891 Census - Address - 100 Bank St, Coatbridge - Ralph Erskine aged 40, Agnes Erskine aged 37, Helen (Ellen) Erskine aged 8, John Erskine aged 6, William B Erskine aged 4, Ralph Erskine aged 1 month and servant Helen Lind aged 17. From the 1901 Census - Address - Wood St, Coatbridge - Ralph C S Erskine aged 50, Agnes Erskine aged 41, Helen (Ellen) B Erskine aged 18, John Erskine aged 16, William B Erskine aged 14, Ralph Erskine aged 10, James B Erskine aged 7, mothers brother James Brown aged 45, servant Mary H Neill. Employment was Clerk with Stewarts and Lloyds, Clyde Tube Works.
