Died of Wounds on the 13/07/1915 received at the Battle of Achi Baba Nullah, Gallipoli, age 19. Son of John (1854 - 1905) and Margaret Wright Gray Ewing (1866 - 1955) of 22e King St, Coatbridge. Gray was named after his mothers maiden name. His late father John had been a China Merchant in Sunnyside Road, Coatbridge. Gray's elder brother Lance Corporal Archibald Ewing of the 13th (Service) Battalion Royal Scots (Lothian Regiment) was Killed in Action on the 06/05/1916. From the 1901 Census - Address - 70g North Academy St, Coatbridge - John Ewing aged 47, Margaret Ewing aged 34, Archibald Ewing aged 7, Gray Ewing aged 5, Elizabeth Ewing aged 2 (1898 - 1980). Gray and Archie's Pensions were awarded to their mother Margaret. Employment was Iron Worker in the Imperial Tube Works.
