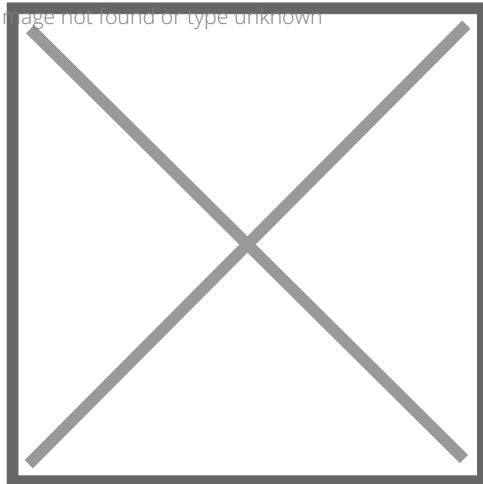

Died of Heart Failure on the 04/06/1917 in a War Hospital in Hawick 1 week after enlisting, age 23. Son of John (03/06/1860 - 23/08/1933) and Mary Feeney Ferns (1857 - 1930). Husband of Ann Jane Gardner Ferns of 12 Carrick St, Coatbridge. From 1901 Census - Address - 15 Carrick St, Coatbridge - John Ferns aged 39, Mary Ferns aged 43, John Ferns aged 10, James Ferns aged 7, boarder Francis Hennon aged 38, mothers son and daughter from previous marriage Thomas Cosgrove aged 23, Margaret Cosgrove, aged 22 (listed as boarders on Census). James' Pension was awarded to his mother Mary and father John of 16 Carrick St, Coatbridge. His wife Ann Jane is also listed. Employment was No data
