



1/7th (Blythswood) Battalion Highland Light Infantry Service No: 36785

Killed in Action on the 27/08/1918 or early 28/08/1918 near Henin (part of the 2nd Battles of the Somme), age No data. Son of Thomas Fletcher. James made a Will leaving all his property to his sister Mrs Annie Barbour of 6 Peel St, Partick, Glasgow. James' Pension was awarded to his aunt Mary Gilchrist of 135 Bank St, Coatbridge on the 31/03/1919. Employment was Iron Worker in the Horse Shoe Works.
