




## Sapper Patrick Gallacher

## **Royal Engineers 19th Divisional Signal Company** Service No: 253303

Died on the 13/11/1918 of Bronchial Pneumonia in the 26th General Hospital, Etaples, age 29 / DOB - 03/06/1889. Son of the late James and the late Bridget Lynch Gallacher. Brother of Henry Gallacher of 158 Dundyvan Rd, Coatbridge. From the 1891 Census - Address - 22 Carrick St, Coatbridge - James Gallacher aged 29, Bridget Gallacher aged 26, Henry Gallacher aged 5, Patrick Gallacher aged 2. Patrick left his effects to his brother Henry which included scissors, knife, rosary, letters, photos, cigarette case and blue linen cap. Henry was his only relative alive along with Henry's 4 children (James, Elizabeth, Francis and Bridget). Patrick's Pension was awarded to his brother Henry on the 26/03/1919. Employment was Iron Dresser.
