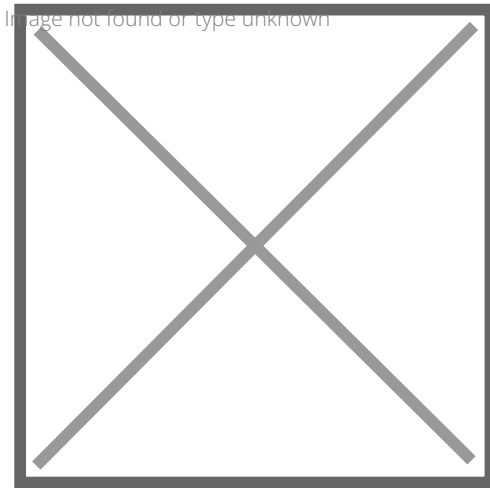

Andrew Rowan Gallocher

**Royal Engineers 1st (Lowland) Field Company (409th)
Service No: 2230**

Died of Wounds to the chest on the 12/04/1916 at the 33rd Casualty Clearing Station in Bethune, age 27. Son of Hugh (09/02/1854 - 04/03/1920) and Sarah McEwen Gallocher of 217 Dundyan Rd, Coatbridge (listed as Waterside, Dalmellington, Ayrshire by the CWGC - this is Andrew's fathers birthplace). Andrew's parents married on the 04/01/1885 in Liverpool. Andrew made a Will leaving all his property and effects to his brother Robert. From the 1901 England Census (Andrew not listed) - Address - 31 Jenkinson St, Everton - Hugh Gallocher aged 47, Sarah Gallocher aged 47, Robert Gallocher aged 13. From the 1891 England Census - Address - 60 Carmel St, Everton - Hugh Gallocher aged 37, Sarah Gallocher aged 37, Agnes Gallocher aged 5, Robert Gallocher aged 3 and Andrew Gallocher aged 2 (all Andrew's family born in Scotland). Andrew's Pension was claimed by his father Hugh but was refused. Employment was Calder Tube Works.
