Killed in Action on the 05/06/1916 at the Hohenzollern Sector, Hulloch, age No data. Son of Peter Gallagher. According to the newspapers of the time Francis was reared by Mrs Docherty, 20 Whittington St, Coatbridge as one of her own. Francis made a Will which took the form of a letter to his aunt Mrs Meechan of Thornaby on Tees. It was written in Aldershot. Francis' Pension was awarded to his father Peter of 25 Whittington St, Coatbridge. Employment was Tinplate Works.
