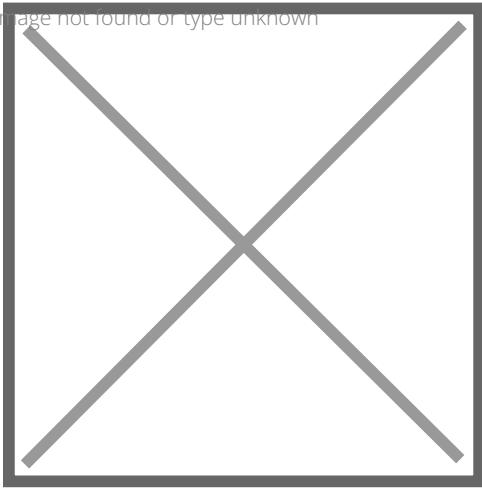

Killed in Action on the 25/09/1915 at Cambrin on the opening day of the Battle of Loos, age 21 / DOB - 28/10/1893. Eldest son of John (03/04/1867 - 14/02/1910) and Mary Gebbie (20/05/1869 - 18/09/1943). John's mother Mary remarried Patrick Collins on the 26/08/1911 and they lived at 5d Turner St, Coatbridge. From the 1901 Census - Address - West Arthurlie Village, Neilston, Barrhead - John Gebbie aged 33, Mary Gebbie aged 32, John Gebbie aged 7, William Gebbie aged 4, Margaret Gebbie aged 2, Matthew Johnstone Gebbie aged 2 months. John also had 3 other sisters, Elizabeth born 1903, Mary born 1905 and Jeanie born 1908. John's Pension was claimed by his mother Mary but was refused as she remarried Patrick Collins. Employment was Moulder in Barrhead / Reservist
