Pioneer George Gordon

Royal Engineers "C" Special Company Service No: 155633

Died of Wounds on the 01/06/1917, age 19 / DOB - 26/09/1897. Son of Alexander Gordon and Annie Ogilvie Gordon of 72a Sunnyside Rd, Coatbridge. George's father was a Sergeant in the Coatbridge Burgh Police. He was the eldest of 6 children. Both his parents were born in Tyrie, Aberdeenshire. From the 1901 Census - Address - Dundyvan Rd, Coatbridge - Alexander Gordon aged 30, Annie Gordon aged 30, George Gordon aged 3, Annie O. Gordon aged 1. George's 4 other brothers were Alexander Gordon born 1902, William John Gordon born 1906, Walter James Gordon born 1909 and Albert Edward Gordon born 1911. George's Pension was awarded to his mother Annie on the 12/12/1917 and the 17/12/1918. Employment was Student at Glasgow University.
