1/4th (Ross Highland) Battalion Seaforth Highlanders Service No: S/4879

Killed in Action on the 24/03/1918 at the 1st Battle of Bapaume (part of the 1st Battles of the Somme 1918), age 26. Eldest son of John Gourlay and Catherine Lavery Gourlay of 7c Henderson St, Coatbridge. Hugh's Pension was awarded to his stepmother Kate Gourlay of 9 Henderson St, Coatbridge on the 06/01/1919. Employment was Miner in Rosehall Colliery.





Buried/remembered at Dernancourt Communal Cemetery Extension (X. E. 18), Somme, France.
