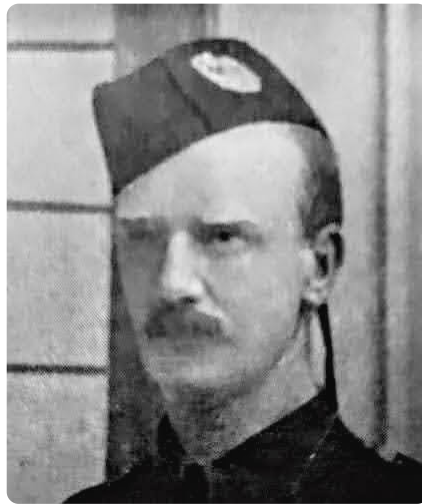

Killed in Action on the 12/09/1916 around Contalmaison, Somme, age 40. Son of Peter and Margaret Gray of Dunoon (previously Mount Florida, Glasgow). Husband of Janet M Gray (16/04/1875 -). John's wife received £3 1s 5d backpay and £3 War Gratuity after his death. From the 1881 Census - Address - 185 Thomson St, Dennistoun, Glasgow - Peter Gray aged 34, Margaret Gray aged 35, Margaret Murray Gray aged 9, Archibald Stirling Gray aged 7, John Murray Gray aged 5, Esther Scott Gray aged 11 months and servant Jessie Crawford aged 18. From the 1901 Census - Address - 93 Somerville Drive, Cathcart - Peter Gray aged 54, Margaret Gray aged 55, John M Gray aged 25, Esther S Gray aged 20, Jane Gray aged 19, Annie M Gray aged 17, Willamina Gray aged 15, Sydney G Gray aged 10. John's Pension was awarded to his wife Janet of 8b West George St, Coatbridge on the 31/03/1917. Employment was with Mr James Miller at the Glasgow Meat Market.
