Killed in Action on the 25/09/1916 at the Battle of Morval (part of the Battles of the Somme), age 22. Son of the late Joseph and Agnes Wright Ashwood of 154d Whifflet St, Coatbridge. Older brother of Driver John Ashwood of the Royal Field Artillery who Died of Wounds on the 21/05/1918. The 1901 Census - Address - 10 Hospital St, Coatbridge - Joseph Ashwood 35, Agnes Ashwood 33, Lizzie Ashwood 8, William Ashwood 6, Joseph Ashwood 6, John Ashwood 5. William's Pension was awarded to his mother Agnes on the 07/08/1917. Employment was Miner in Rosehall Colliery.
