Killed in Action on the 25/09/1916 at the Battle of Morval (part of the Battles of the Somme), age 22. Son of the late Joseph Ashwood (1865 - 22/12/1912) and Agnes Wright Ashwood (27/08/1867 - 27/08/1919) of 154d Whifflet St, Coatbridge. Elder brother of Driver John Ashwood (93209) of the Royal Field Artillery who Died of Wounds on the 21/05/1918. The 1901 Census - Address - 10 Hospital St, Coatbridge - Joseph Ashwood 35, Agnes Ashwood 33, Lizzie Ashwood 8, William Ashwood 6, Joseph Ashwood 6, John Ashwood 5. William's Pension was awarded to his mother Agnes on the 07/08/1917. Sadly she died in 1919. William's father Joseph died in 1912. Employment was Miner in Rosehall Colliery.
