Killed in Action on the 21/05/1916 in the Loos Salient, age 31. Son of John and Margaret Murray Hendrie of 239/b2 Main St, Coatbridge. Husband of Jane (Jeanie) Howieson Hendrie (31/12/1893 -) of 260 Halliburton Pl, Galashiels. Father of George Hendrie born 07/06/1916. George was the older brother of Private Matthew Hendrie of the 2nd Battalion Highland Light Infantry who Died of Wounds on the 08/12/1916. Younger brother John did not go to War due to a leg injury received at a Foundry. From the 1901 Census - Address - 62 Long Row, Coatbridge - John Hendry aged 42, Maggie Hendry aged 40, Thomas Hendry aged 19, George Hendry aged 17, Matthew Hendry aged 10, Maggie Hendry aged 6, Sarah Hendry aged 5, John Hendry aged 1. George's Pension was awarded to his wife Jane of 133 Haliburton Place, Galashiels on the 01/12/1916. Employment was Lochrin Iron Works / Apprentice Moulder in 1901.
