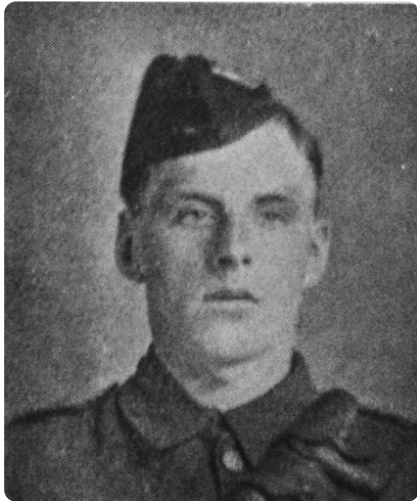

Matthew Eliot Hendrie

**2nd Battalion Highland Light Infantry
Service No: 8148**

Died of Wounds (gun shot) on the 08/12/1916 in a Boulogne Hospital , age 25 / DOB - 12/06/1891. Son of John and Margaret Murray Hendrie of 239/b2 Main St, Coatbridge. Younger brother of Lance Corporal George Hendrie of the 12th Battalion Highland Light Infantry who was Killed in Action on the 21/05/1916. Matthew's younger brother John did not go to War due to a leg injury received at a Foundry. Matthew left a Will leaving all belongings to his mother and father. From the 1901 Census - Address - 62 Long Row, Coatbridge - John Hendry aged 42, Maggie Hendry aged 40, Thomas Hendry aged 19, George Hendry aged 17, Matthew Hendry aged 10, Maggie Hendry aged 6, Sarah Hendry aged 5, John Hendry aged 1. Matthew's Pension was awarded to his mother Margaret on the 22/06/1917. Employment was Lochrin Iron Works / Reservist.
