



## 2nd Battalion Leinster Regiment Service No: 7362 (Sergeant)

Died on the 07/11/1918 of dysentery at the 11th Casualty Clearing Station at Lille., age 32 / 05/04/1885. Son of James Hickey and Abina Hickey of 5 Doonpeter, Glenville, Cork, Ireland. Husband of Ellen Hickey (nee Collins), of 34, Bannerman St., Kilbowie Rd. Clydebank, Glasgow (listed as 627 Glasgow Rd, Clydebank in 1919) and father of 2 sons. From the 1901 Ireland Census - Address - 5 Doonpeter, Glenville, Cork - James Hickey aged 50, Albina Hickey aged 40, Denis Hickey aged 17, Eliza Hickey aged 15, Norah Hickey aged 12, John Hickey aged 9, David Hickey aged 8, Mary Hickey aged 6, Hanna Hickey aged 3, Ellen Hickey aged 2. From the 1911 Ireland Census - Address - 4 Doonpeter, Glenville, Cork - James Hickey aged 65, Albina Hickey aged 48, Denis Hickey aged 26, Norah Hickey aged 22, John Hickey aged 20, David Hickey aged 18, Mollie Hickey aged 15, Ellie Hickey aged 11, Bridget Hickey aged 9, James Hickey aged 5. Denis' Pension was awarded to his wife Ellen of 18 George Crescent, Radnor Park, Clydebank. Employment was Farmers son / Regular soldier
