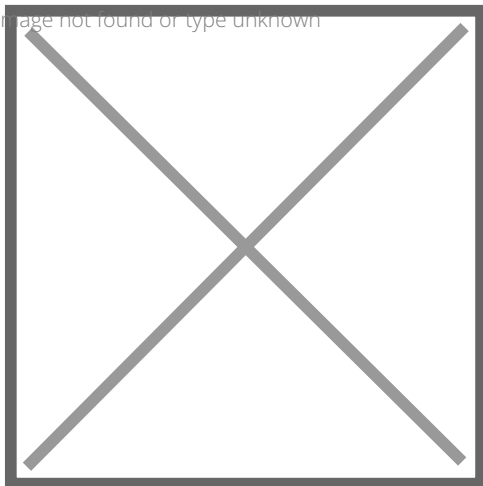

Killed in Action on the 14/07/1916 at the Battle of Bazentin Ridge (part of the Battles of the Somme), age 29. From the Ireland 1901 Census - Address - Prospect Avenue, Drogheda, Co. Louth - Head of Family - Michael Hogg aged 21. Sisters and Brothers - Ellen Hogg aged 19, Maggie Hogg aged 17, James Hogg aged 14, John Hogg aged 12. James also had a brother named Allen E Hogg. Employment was Labourer in the British Tube Works.
