Sergeant Thomas Humm D.C.M.

2nd Battalion Black Watch (Royal Highlanders) Service No: 9260

Killed in Action on the 21/01/1916 at the Attack on Hanna (part of the efforts to relieve Kut), age 28. Son of David and Jane Ann Humm. Nephew of Mr and Mrs Samuel Lindsay of Groveside Cottage, Kipps, Coatbridge. Younger brother of Private David Humm of the 252nd Company Machine Gun Corps who died in bed of natural causes in Russia 01/02/1919. Thomas and his brother David lived with their cousin Private Samuel P Lindsay (36522) of the 16th (Service) Battalion (2nd Glasgow) Highland Light Infantry who was Killed in Action on the 28/11/1917. From 1891 Census - Address - Broompark Pl, Stonefield Road, Blantyre - David Humm aged 47, Jane Ann Humm aged 37, Jane S Humm aged 7, David G Humm aged 6, Thomas Humm aged 3, Robert Humm aged 1. Employment was Regular Soldier.
