Killed in Action on the 16/05/1915 from a snipers bullet on the 2nd day of the Battle of Festubert, age 23 / DOB - 13/12/1891. Eldest son of Thomas Russell Hutton (1864 - 27/06/1945) and Margaret Brownlie Hutton (13/02/1868 - 08/01/1949) of 6 Bute Terrace, Whifflet, Coatbridge. Elder brother of Lance Corporal John Brownlie Hutton of the 6th (Service) Battalion Cameron Highlanders who was Killed in Action on the 26/09/1915. From the 1901 Census - Address - 267 Dundyan Rd, Coatbridge - Thomas Hutton aged 34, Margaret Hutton aged 32, Margaret Hutton aged 11 (1890 - 21/12/1975), James Hutton aged 9, John Hutton aged 6, Mary Hutton aged 1, boarder John Brownlie aged 72. James and his brother John's Pension was awarded to their mother Margaret. Employment was Clerk in the Scottish Iron and Steel Works, Glasgow.
