Lance Corporal John Brownlie Hutton

6th (Service) Battalion Cameron Highlanders "B" Company No. 7 Platoon Service No: S/14732

Killed in Action on the 26/09/1915 on the 2nd day of the Battle of Loos, age 21. Son of Thomas Russell Hutton (1864 - 27/06/1945) and Margaret Brownlie Hutton (13/02/1868 - 08/01/1949) of 6 Bute Terrace, Whifflet, Coatbridge. Younger brother of Private James Russell Hutton of the 2nd Battalion Gordon Highlanders who was Killed in Action on the 16/05/1915. From the 1901 Census - Address - 267 Dundyvan Rd, Coatbridge - Thomas Hutton aged 34, Margaret Hutton aged 32, Margaret Hutton aged 11 (1890 - 21/12/1975), James Hutton aged 9, John Hutton aged 6, Mary Hutton aged 1, boarder John Brownlie aged 72. John and his brother James' Pension was awarded to their mother Margaret. Employment was Clerk in the Tinplate Works / Structural Engineer.
