

Patrick Joseph Aloysius Lavelle

1/5th Battalion Royal Scots Fusiliers attached to 155th Trench Mortar Battery Service No: N/A

Killed in Action on the 04/10/1918 during the Final Advance in Artois, age 24. Son of Provost John Lavelle and Alice Lavelle of Brankle House, Blairhill, Coatbridge. Patrick's older brother 2nd Lieutenant James Lavelle of the 12th Battalion Highland Light Infantry was Killed in Action on the 20/08/1915. His younger brother Thomas was an Officer in the Royal Flying Corps. From the 1901 Census - Address - Brankle House, Coatbridge - John Lavell aged 42, Alice Lavell aged 35, James Lavell aged 10, Alice Lavell aged 9, Annie Lavell aged 8, Patrick Lavell aged 6, John Lavell aged 4, Thomas Lavell aged 3, Margaret Lavell aged 1, Sarah Feenan aged 24, Jessie Reid aged 19, Fanny Reid aged 12. Employment was Medical Student at Glasgow University.
