



Private John Laughran (Loughran)

Tank Corps Service No: 305152

Died of Pneumonia on the 27/10/1918 at the 16th General Hospital, Le Treport, age 21. Son of Thomas Laughran (28/06/1859 - 27/04/1902) and Ellen / Helen Laughran (25/10/1862 - 17/09/1932) of 9 Manse St, Coatbridge. In his Will dated 03/03/1916 John left the whole of his property and effects to his mother. John's father Thomas died of meningitis on the 27/04/1902 and his mother Ellen died after being knocked down by a car in Park St, Coatbridge on the 17/09/1932. John's brothers and sisters were, Margaret (10/08/1888 - 1978), Francis (1889 -), Catherine (20/12/1891 - 1980), Henry (17/08/1893 - 1972) and Thomas (07/05/1895 - 16/11/1903). John's mother Ellen applied for his Pension on the 17/05/1919. Employment was No data
