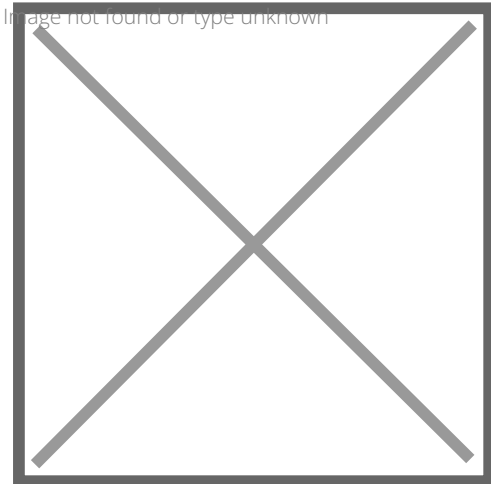

**Thomas Loughran**

**2nd Battalion Cameronians (Scottish Rifles)  
Service No: 11923**

Killed in Action on the 23/10/1916 during the Battles of the Somme, age 39. Eldest son of William Loughran ( - 18/08/1904) and Agnes Loughran (1859 - 28/03/1936) of 106a Main St, Coatbridge. Thomas' brother Corporal John Loughran was in training with the Cyclist Corps at the time of his death. Another brother James was discharged with foot trouble. From the 1881 Census - Address - 4 Main St, Airdrie - William Loughran aged 24, Ann Loughran aged 22, Thomas Loughran aged 4, Margaret Loughran aged 2 ( -02/10/1952), James Loughran ( - 10/04/1943) aged 7 months. Thomas' Pension was awarded to his mother Agnes on the 18/07/1917. Employment was Phoenix Iron Works.
