Killed in Action on the 26/09/1915 on the 2nd day of the Battle of Loos, age 19. Son of Walter and Jane Mitchell of 40 Long Row, Gartsherrie, Coatbridge. From the 1901 Census - Address - 320 Cornish Row, Coatbridge - Walter Mitchell aged 43, Jane Mitchell aged 35, Jane Mitchell aged 12, Christina Mitchell aged 8, Thomas Mitchell aged 5, Maggie Mitchell aged 3, Andrew Bell Mitchell aged 6 months, Walter's brother Thomas Mitchell aged 27, boarder James Agnew aged 17. Thomas' Pension was awarded to his mother Jane on the 22/07/1916. Employment was Iron Worker (Furnaceman) with William Baird and Company.
