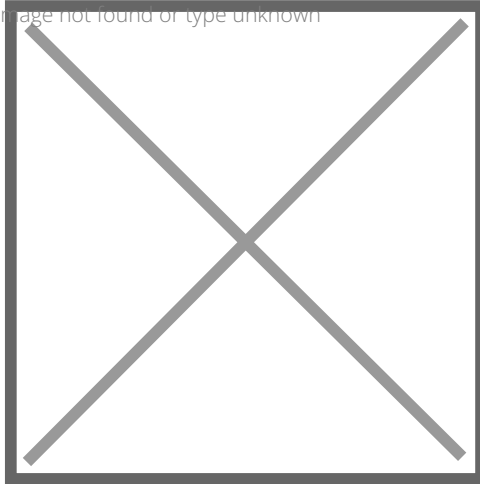

Killed in Action on the 04/11/1918 at the Battle of the Sambre (part of the Final Advance in Picardy), age 22. Son of Richard and Ann Robertson Morris of 1 Kildonan St, Coatbridge. From the 1901 Census - Address - 4 East Canal St, Coatbridge - Richard Morris aged 27, Ann Morris aged 29, John Morris aged 4, Sarah Morris aged 2, Mary Morris aged 1 month. John's Pension was originally awarded to his father Richard of Viewfield St, Harthill. After his death it was awarded to his mother Annie of 74 Dunbeth Rd, Coatbridge on the 07/05/1919.
