



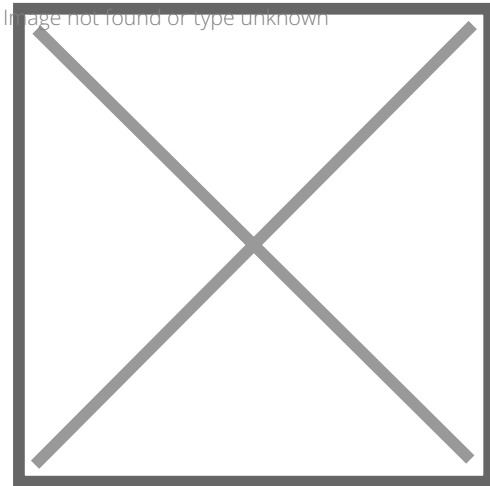

Killed in Action on the 06/07/1916 at the Battle of Albert (opening phase of the Battles of the Somme), age 28. Son of James and Alice Mullin. From the 1891 Census - Address - 63 Trafalgar Lane, Leith - James Mullin aged 44, Alice Mullin aged 43, James Mullin aged 20, Maryanne Mullin aged 18, Isabella Mullin aged 16, Hugh Mullin aged 9, William Mullin aged 5. Employment was Tube Worker in the British Tube Works
