Killed in Action on the 01/09/1918 at the Advance in Flanders, age 18. Son of John McEwan of 31g Lock St, Coatbridge. David's brother Private William McEwan of the 9th (Service) Battalion (Pioneers) North Staffordshire Regiment was Killed in Action on the 11/04/1918. Both brothers worked in the Union Tube Works before enlisting. David's Pension was awarded to his father John. Employment was Union Tube Works
