Killed in Action on the 11/04/1918 at the 1st Battle of the Scarpe (part of the Battle of Arras), age No data. Son of John McEwan of 31g Lock St, Coatbridge. Brother of Private David McEwan of the 1/5th (Dumfries and Galloway) Battalion King's Own Scottish Borderers who was Killed in Action on the 01/09/1918. Both brothers worked in the Union Tube Works before enlisting. In his Will dated 05/01/1917 William left all his property and effects to his sister Maggie. His Pension was awarded to his father John. Employment was Union Tube Works
