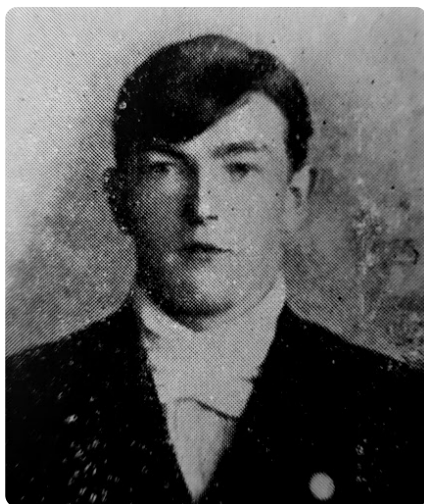

Killed in Action on the 01/07/1916 at the Battle of Albert (opening phase of the Battles of the Somme) , age No data. Son of John McGillivray of 100 Sunnyside Rd, Coatbridge. Alexander made a Will leaving all his effects to his father John. Alexander's brother Private James McGillivray (S/9091) of the 1st Battalion Seaforth Highlanders was Killed in Action on the 22/04/1916. He served with the ALIAS Private James McRoberts. Alexander and James' Pensions were awarded to their father. Employment was North British Railway Company
