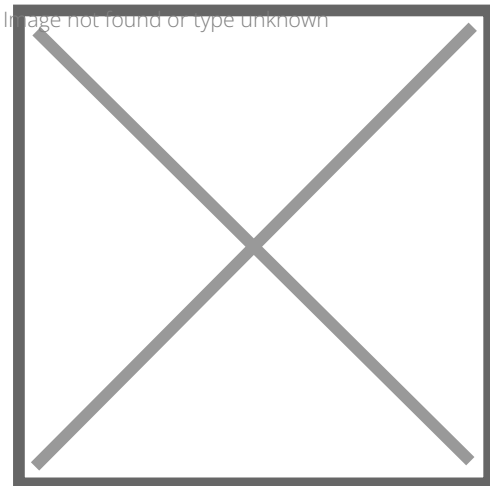

Killed in Action on the 03/05/1915 at Hill 60 during the Battle of St. Julien (part of the 2nd Battle of Ypres), age 42. Son of Elizabeth McGraw. Brother of Mrs Elizabeth Windsor of 7 Hutton St, Coatbridge. Michael lived with his sister and her husband Hugh and their daughter Elizabeth at their 1891 address 12 Lang St, Coatbridge. From the 1881 Census - Address - Addies Square, Coatbridge - Elizabeth McGraw aged 46, James McGraw aged 19, Elizabeth McGraw aged 17, Thomas McGraw aged 15, John McGraw aged 13, Michael McGraw aged 11, Joseph McGraw aged 8, Catherine McGraw aged 6, William McGraw aged 5. From the 1891 Census - Address - 12 Lang St, Coatbridge - Hugh Windsor aged 25, Elizabeth Windsor aged 25, Elizabeth Windsor aged 9 months, Michael McGraw aged 19. Employment was Tube Worker in the British Tube Works previously a Coal Miner.
