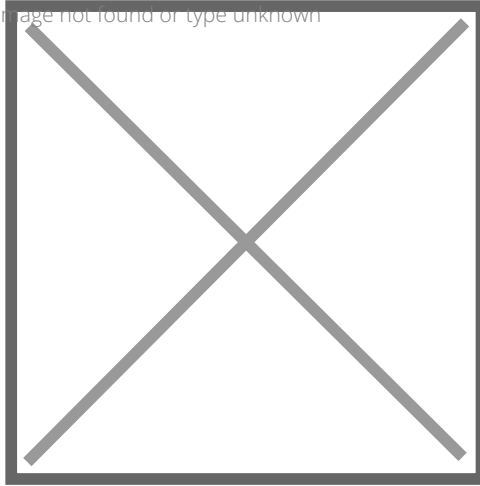

Killed in Action on the 05/10/1918 at Meurchin, northeast of Lens (part of the Final Advance in Artois), age 18. Son of Robert and Margaret McBrier of Palacecraig Lodge, Airdrie. From the 1901 Census - Address - 283 New Row, Coatbridge - Robert McBrier aged 34, Margaret A McBrier aged 31, Mary J McBrier aged 11, John McBrier aged 9, Margaret A McBrier aged 7, Ellen McBrier aged 5, James McBrier aged 1. James' Pension was awarded to his mother Margaret of 279 New Row, Coatbridge then Palacecraig Lodge, Airdrie. Employment was William Baird and Company
